Please note these guidelines will apply from 10th October 2021 and have been agreed by the Leadership Team, with a view to keeping all members of the congregation safe and well.

We would encourage ALL who are planning to come to a Church service to take a Lateral Flow Test prior to coming to Church, either on the morning or evening before.

Feeling unwell?

Please do not come to church if you are showing symptoms of COVID-19
or feeling unwell with colds etc.

Arriving at church

Please use the main door which is marked with an entrance sign.
If you find yourself having to queue, please remember to keep your distance.

Entering the building

On entry, there is a hand sanitiser point, please use it to minimise the spread of the virus.
Track and Trace (if someone reports symptoms of COVID-19), a record will need to be made of your name and contact details. This information will be destroyed after 21 days.

Face masks

These will be optional

Seating

There will be an area for those wishing to wear masks and continue to sit 2 metres apart

Singing in Church

if you are sitting in the balcony, please do continue to wear your Face Mask while singing in order to keep others safe who are sitting below

Leaving the building

Please leave in an orderly way, remembering to keep your distance
there may be people who still wish to keep the 2 metre gap.

Will now be available for coffee and chat, we recommend the tables and chairs are used
Windows and doors will be open, so please wear suitable clothing
Please note that it is recommended that the
maximum number of people in the kitchen at any one time should be restricted to 2
